



# DISCOVERY 947 RIDE JOBURG WATER POINT SPONSORSHIP

For the first time in the II years of the Cycle Challenge – the naming rights sponsor has opted not take the ownership and branding of the 9 water points on route – (this had been closely guarded by previous sponsors in the past Momentum and Telkom) it's a unique opportunity to interact with the thousands of cyclists on the route and feel the vibe and support those Riding for a Purpose.

There are 9 strategically placed Water Points on route and now is the chance for your company to show their support for the iconic Joburg event and the cyclists on the route.

Whether you use it as a **team building event for your staff**, or you are supporting your colleagues riding, or you simply want Joburg know you support Ride Joburg or looking to get your company name out there – peruse this document and we challenge you to be part of this exciting day

Each water point supplies cyclists cold Bonaqua water, Powerade, Coca-Cola either to onboard at the water point or to fill the cyclists water bottle. In addition, each water point has a medical and physio station, a mechanical station and toilets. Strategically placed water points will also have nutrition and energy supplements, much needed over the gruelling route.

The water points are both a necessity, in terms of hydration and refuelling, and a motivational break.

Each water point offers the sponsor an opportunity to brand both functionally and creatively.

The Ride Joburg provides and covers the cost of hydration, racefood, physios, medical crew, infrastructure (tables, chairs, baths, ice baths, dustbins, toilets, security, water point captains, cups etc...) and transport thereof.

The water point sponsor would need cover the costs of crew, t-shirts, caps, transport of crew, food for all working crew, sponsor branding, music and entertainment at each point.
