



### **Checklist and final instructions**

#### 1. Kids Ride race number

Remember your child's race number and attach it to the front of their T-shirt.

If your child is in the Birds group, you would have received two identical numbers. Attach the first number to the front of their T-shirt and the second number to the front of your own T-shirt. Remember the race number is the unique identifying number that can assist the organisers if your child gets lost on the day.

# 2. Event T-shirt and goody bag

Each rider gets a T-shirt and a Spur goody bag. These can be collected at number collection. Remember to have your child wear the T-shirt on the day.

#### 3. Sunblock and hat

While it's great to be out in the sun, please make sure your child a hat and sunscreen to protect their skin.

#### 4. Helmet

No helmet = no ride

# 5. Get your child's bike ready a week before event day

Make sure your child's bike is in good working order. Avoid disappointment and don't leave maintenance until the last minute. There will be a bike mechanic at the venue selling minor accessories. Bring some cash along in case of a bike-repair emergency.

Remember to be at the holding area at least 30 min before your start time. Each group will be split into manageable start batches.

# **Venue and route at Steyn City**

Steyn City is situated north of Fourways on the R511. Familiarise yourself with the venue and parking plan to make sure your day is hassle-free.

Spur is our official partner, so treat your kids to a juicy Spur burger and chips for lunch and enjoy some fun and games at the Spur Kids Play Area.

The Kids Ride winds through the picturesque Steyn City. You will be able to see the kids riding for about 90% of the route, but some sections may be hidden from view. There are spectator areas along the route where you can view the kids as they tackle the course.

Cheer the mini athletes along the route or wait for their return at the finish where you can picnic after the race. Bring along chairs and an umbrella for extra shade.

# Parking access through Cedar Road gatehouse and Runnymead Road only

Parking for the event will be at Steyn City, as indicated on the venue map. You can **only** access the venue from the Cedar Road gatehouse or the Runnymead Gate on Runnymead Road. William Nicol gatehouse is closed to the public.

Please take care when driving through the parking area as the surface is slightly uneven. Drop a pin on your smartphone to geo-locate your parking spot. This will make finding your vehicle after the event easier.

# **Holding area**

Please be patient when in the holding area and listen to the instructions given by the event crew.

### **Start information**

Please take note of the start times on first page. Each group will be called over the sound system 30 minutes before their time slot. When the call is made, please make your way towards the holding area.

Each category (Birds, Meerkats, Lions and Elephants) will be split into smaller batches to start them in manageable groups.

#### Children

We recommend that you write your cellphone number on your child's arm. Another way you can make sure your child is identified, if you lose track of them during the day, is to take a photo of your child in the morning.
